Public Lands District (P-L)
List of Permitted Uses

The Los Alamos County Code establishes Zoning Districts as shown on the Official Zoning Map. The P-L public land district is intended to accommodate local government and school district uses and structures, designed to support community needs and the public health, safety and welfare.

The following uses are **permitted** in the P-L District:

In addition, the following uses are permitted with a **Special Use Permit** in the P-L District, which requires review and approval by the Planning and Zoning Commission at a public hearing:
