



Los Alamos County
Recreation Wilderness District (W-2)
List of Permitted Uses

The Los Alamos County Code establishes Zoning Districts as shown on the Official Zoning Map. The W-2 recreation wilderness district is intended to maintain, protect and preserve the scenic and environmental quality, open character and natural recreational value of undeveloped land; and to accommodate public and private recreational uses of an open nature.

The following uses are **permitted** in the W-2 District:

- Cemeteries
- Public buildings
- Radio and TV, Studios/stations
- Campgrounds
- Parks and playgrounds, public and private

In addition, the following uses are permitted with a **Special Use Permit** in the W-2 District, which requires review and approval by the Planning and Zoning Commission at a public hearing:

- Caretaker's unit
- Public utilities
- Radio and TV, towers/antennas
- Satellite dish antennas
- Riding academies, arenas and/or stables
- Recreation facilities
- Swimming pools, commercial or clubs

The following uses are permitted as **Accessory** Uses, incidental and subordinate to the permitted or special use, in the W-2 District:

- Greenhouses
- Day care homes

Note: This information is for reference purposes only. Other regulations, including provision of sufficient parking, will apply. All new or changed uses may be subject to inspection, licensing and issuance of Certificates of Occupancy.
