

For horse show purposes, the age of the exhibitor as of January 1, 2019, will be maintained throughout the year. Horses of any breed or combination of breeds may be entered. **There will be no stallions allowed in youth classes, other than colts under one year in Showmanship at Halter.** The Judge or Show Management may excuse unmannerly or unruly horses from the arena and/or show grounds.

- Fees:
 - \$5.00 per youth class entry participant
 - \$8.00 per adult class entry participant

Fees will be accepted by the Los Alamos County Recreation Division at 2760 Canyon Road, Los Alamos, NM, 87544. Any questions please call (505) 662-8170. NO REFUNDS will be made for any reason except the incapacitating injury or illness of the contestant or horse.

- Awards: English (E) and Western (W) designate what points will be given under each division.
 - Ribbons will be awarded to 6th Place.
 - High point awards will be presented for each age group.
 - Each horse will be given points: 1st earns six points, 2nd earns five points, 3rd earns four points, 4th earns three points, 5th earns two points, 6th earns one point.

If a horse is ridden in more than one age group, only the highest placing in each event will count towards high-point awards. If a rider competes on more than one horse, only the highest placing will count toward high-point awards. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel and combine classes.

Each exhibitor will be assigned a number that is to be displayed at all times. Post entries close at first call of each class. For example, when the first age group enters for halter, all halter classes are closed to entry. Exhibitors must notify the paddock master for tack changes at least one class prior to the change. There will be a five-minute gate for tack changes and a one-minute gate for missing contestants, after which the class will be closed. This rule will be strictly enforced.

AQHA rules and regulations will be adhered to except during the Challenge Walk Trot and Lead Line Class. The Horse Show Committee/Judges will rule on any discrepancies, unless otherwise stated in the premium list. Any complaints should be made to, and will be settled by, the Horse Show Committee/Judges.

- **Appointments:** Entries in all riding classes (except challenge walk trot) shall be shown with western/English type equipment.
 - Entries must wear the proper dress and use the proper tack for western/English classes.
 - The AQHA rulebook must sanction all bits. Mechanical hackamores, tied own, nosebands, running martingales, or draw reins are prohibited except in the timed events.
 - Curb chains must be a least ½" wide and lie flat against the horse's jaw.
- **Western Attire/Equipment:** Horse will be shown in a western saddle and bridle (per AQHA rule book).
 - Riders must wear western pants, long sleeve shirt, western hat or helmet (English helmet OK) and boots with a heel.
 - There will be an exception for the timed events, when riders will not have to wear a hat. If you wear a hat, it must stay on your body for the entire run, or there will be a five-second penalty.
- **English Attire/Equipment:** Horse will be shown in an English saddle and bridle (per AQHA rule book).
 - Riders must wear English attire (including a helmet), jackets/gloves optional.

I acknowledge that there are certain hazards and risks inherent in the Los Alamos County Horse Show, and I understand and appreciate the nature of the risks. I understand that these hazards or risks could result in property damage, illness, bodily injury or death to myself, my family members, or my guests. I agree to fully explain these risks to my family members and my guests prior to the activity.

I also agree to abide by the rules and policies established by the Los Alamos County Parks, Recreation and Open Space Division. For the safety of, and in fairness for, all contestants working in a class, persons outside the arena should not assist riders inside the arena in anyway. The Ring Steward and the Judge control the conduct of the classes; other unauthorized persons should not enter the arena without the acknowledgement or permission of these officials.

In consideration of your acceptance of this entry by my signature, intending to be legally bound for myself, my heirs, executors, and administrators, I waive and release any and all rights and claims for damages I may have against the organizers of the County for any and all injuries sustained and suffered by me during this event.

IN CASE OF INJURY OR INABILITY TO FINISH THE COMPETITION, I HEREBY GRANT THE LOS ALAMOS COUNTY PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACE DIVISION PERMISSION TO TRANSPORT ME / MY CHILD TO THE NEAREST MEDICAL FACILITY.

I have carefully read this statement and understand it to be a release of all claims and causes of action for illness, injury or death that occur while participating in the Los Alamos County Horse Show, and an agreement to indemnify Los Alamos County for losses, damages and liabilities that may arise as a result of participation in this activity.
