





KIDS: Atomic City Transit buses are different than school buses. Review this book and a route map with an adult and have them ride with you at least once before you ride alone so you can practice these safety tips.




Hi! I'm Driver Dan and I drive an Atomic City Transit bus. I'd like to tell you about riding public transit. Most Atomic City Transit buses are blue, orange and green, except for the trolley. It's red and green.




Arrive at your bus stop five minutes early and stand at least four giant steps back from the curb.




When you see the bus coming, give a big wave to be sure the driver sees you.



When the bus stops,
first let other riders
get off of the bus
before you get on.



If you have a bike, tell the driver and then hang it on the bus bike rack before you board.



As you board, tell the driver where you're headed and quickly find a seat. Move to an inside seat and put your belongings in your lap.


If all the seats are taken, move towards the back of the bus & hold the handrail.

BE COURTEOUS




1. Please give your seat to an elderly or disabled person if the bus is full.
2. Speak in a normal voice when talking to riders or on a cell phone. Don't yell.

Cross out the kids breaking the rules.
Circle and color the kids following the rules.



3. Keep your head & arms inside the bus at all times, especially on the trolley.
4. Profanity, coarse joking, & unruly behavior is not allowed on the bus.



Remind the driver when you're close to your destination. Check your seat for your belongings. Thank the driver if you've enjoyed your ride. Let the driver know if you have a bike on the rack to pick up.






Answers: Atomic City Transit, bus stops, route map, bus drivers, safety, seats, be respectful

Don't run.




Take four giant steps
away from the bus.


Wait until the bus leaves.



Then, if you need to cross the street, look both ways to make sure that it is safe before you cross. Only cross the street behind the bus and never in front. ACT buses do not have school flashers that require traffic to stop, so watch for traffic.


