If approved for emergency use, that vaccine could ship out by the end of February.</p> <p>No information on AstraZeneca at this time.</p> <p>“Red to Green” framework. Reopening Level Metrics Counties shall be categorized according to one of the following levels: Green Level- Counties seeking to operate at this level must satisfy both of the following metrics: A New COVID-19 case incidence rate of no greater than 8 cases per 100,000 inhabitanace during the most recent two-week period, AND An average percent of positive COVID-19 test results over the most recent 14-day period of less than or equal to 5% Yellow Level- Counties seeking to operate at this level must meet either of the following metrics: A New COVID-19 case incidence rate of no greater than 8 cases per 100,000 inhabitanace during the most recent two-week period, OR An average percent of positive COVID-19 test results over the most recent 14-day period of less than or equal to 5% Red Level- All other counties shall operate at the Red Level.
