FIREWORKS DISPLAY INFORMATION	<u>NFPA 1123 Code for Fireworks Display 2014 Edition</u> (Portions of NFPA 1123 are listed below, however all requirements of the standard shall be complied with.)
	<u>Scope:</u> (1) Construction, handling, and use of fireworks and equipment intended for outdoor fireworks display (2) Operation of the display.
	<u>Definitions:</u> Fireworks. Any composition or device for the purpose of producing a visible or an audible effect for entertainment purposes by combustion, deflagration, or detonation, that meets the definition of <i>Consumer Fireworks</i> or <i>Display Fireworks</i> as set forth in this code. Discharge Site. The area immediately surrounding the location where fireworks and other devices are ignited for a display. Display Site. The immediate area where a fireworks display is conducted, including the discharge site, the fallout area, and the required separation distance from mortars to spectator viewing areas, but not spectator viewing areas or vehicle parking areas.
	<u>Site Plan.</u> A site plan shall be submitted to the AHJ within a time period required by the AHJ prior to the display. The site plan shall include the dimensions of the display site and location of discharge site(s), spectator viewing area(s), parking area(s), fallout area(s), and the associated separation distances. After review of the site plan, the AHJ shall inspect the area depicted on the site plan. When trenches or holes are dug into the ground in order to place mortars, the operator shall consult with the sponsor and the AHJ in order to locate any buried utility lines in the discharge site.
	<u>Control of Ignition Sources.</u> Smoking materials, matches, lighters, or open flame devices shall not be permitted within 50 ft (15 m) of any area where fireworks or other pyrotechnic materials are present.
	<u>General Requirements.</u> The sponsor of the display shall make provisions for fire protection for the display. Monitors shall be positioned around the display site to prevent spectators or any other unauthorized persons from entering the discharge site.
	<u>Notification</u> The Los Alamos Fire Department requires notification prior to the commencement of fireworks display. Half an hour prior to operation, you must notify the following agencies: the Los Alamos County Fire Department at 663-1843 and the Los Alamos Consolidated Dispatch Center at 662-8222.
