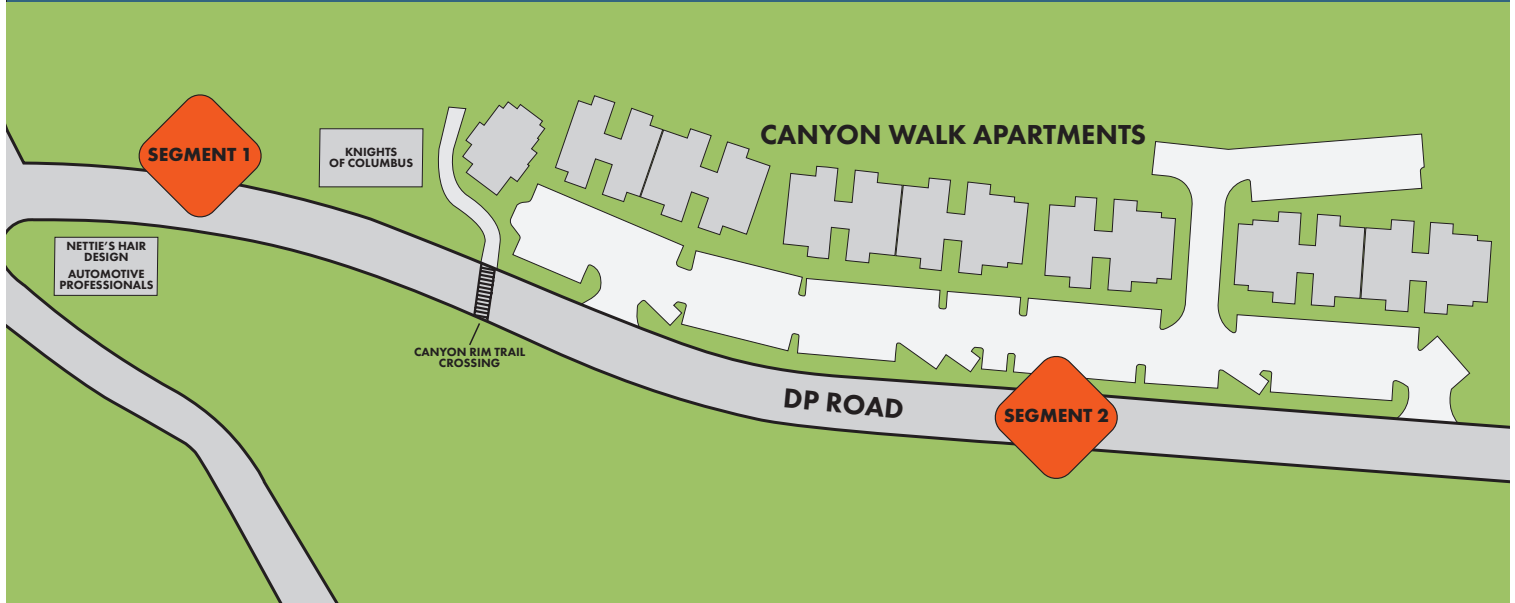


PUBLIC NOTICE: DP ROAD CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



Bethel Development and their contractors began infrastructure work on DP Road on September 14. The work will continue over the next ten weeks and is necessary to connect the new Canyon Walk Apartments to water and sewer. A brief summary of work expected to occur that may cause delays for motorists traveling to businesses located on DP Road is below:

PHASE I: Milling of DP Road from Trinity Drive to the Fire Station (Segment 1 and 2) has been completed. Then, for approximately four weeks, work will include the installation of utilities and the new road and sidewalks will be constructed from Trinity Drive to the Canyon Rim Trail crossing (Segment 1) During Phase 1, traffic will be limited to one lane through Segment 1 and will be controlled by a flagging operation. Additionally, during this phase, the north side of Segment 2 will be paved in preparation for the traffic detour that will occur during Phase 2. Following completion of this phase, DP road will revert to two-way traffic operations through Segment 1.

PHASE II: During this phase, construction will shift to Segment 2 of DP Road from the Canyon Rim Trail crossing to the Fire Station. For approximately six weeks, work will include the installation of utilities and the new road and sidewalks will be constructed. During Phase II, traffic will be limited to one lane along the north shoulder through Segment 2 and will be controlled by a flagging operation.

Near the end of this phase for approximately one week, the one lane detour will shift from the north side to the south side of DP road to complete the utility connections for Canyon Walk Apartments.

Access to businesses will be maintained in all segments of the project. Work may occur 7 days a week from 7 a.m.–7 p.m.

The Canyon Rim Trail will remain open for the majority of this project. Closure of the Canyon Rim Trail at the crossing and the section from DP Road behind the Canyon Walk Apartments site is expected during several different days. Signs about closures will be posted on the trail and public notice will be provided to the media ahead of the anticipated closures
