- NMDOT CN5101970
- Construction Funding

Federal Funds:	\$598,080
Local Match:	\$101,920
Total	\$700,000
- Federal Funding = Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) Flex Funding FY26



PINON SCHOOL TRAIL CONNECTION PROJECT DETAILS

- Provides an ADA Compliant trail connection to Grand Canyon Drive and Pinon Elementary School from the NM-4 Crossing & Multi-Use Trail Project
- Full NEPA Procedures being followed.
- Easement has been obtained from Los Alamos Public Schools to allow this trail section to be incorporated into the project.
- ~850 linear feet of existing trail reconstruction along the west side of the school campus to improve the existing trail condition and accessibility.

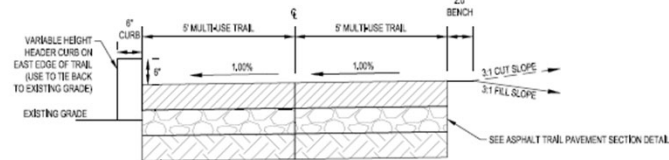

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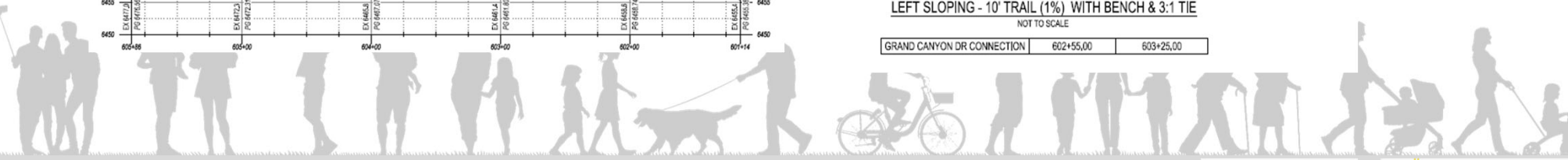

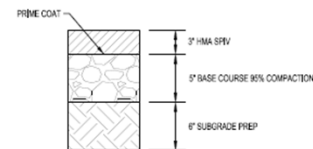
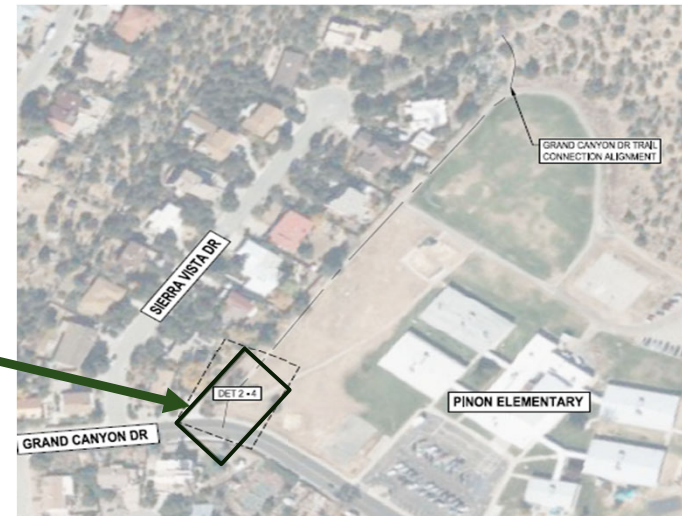
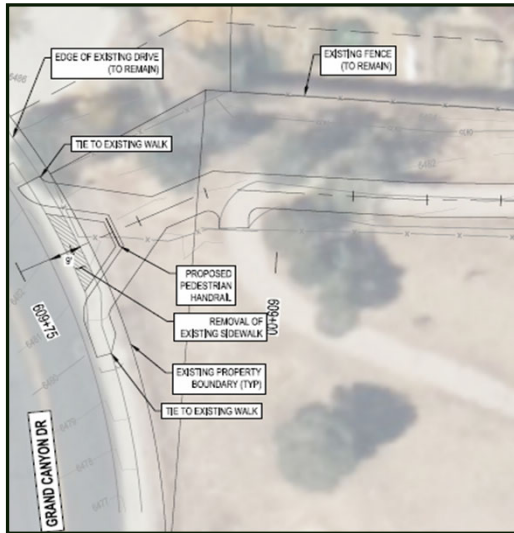
TRAIL TYPICAL SECTION

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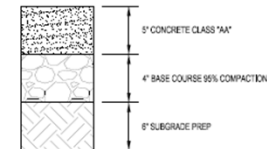

NM4 Crossing & Multi Use Trail:

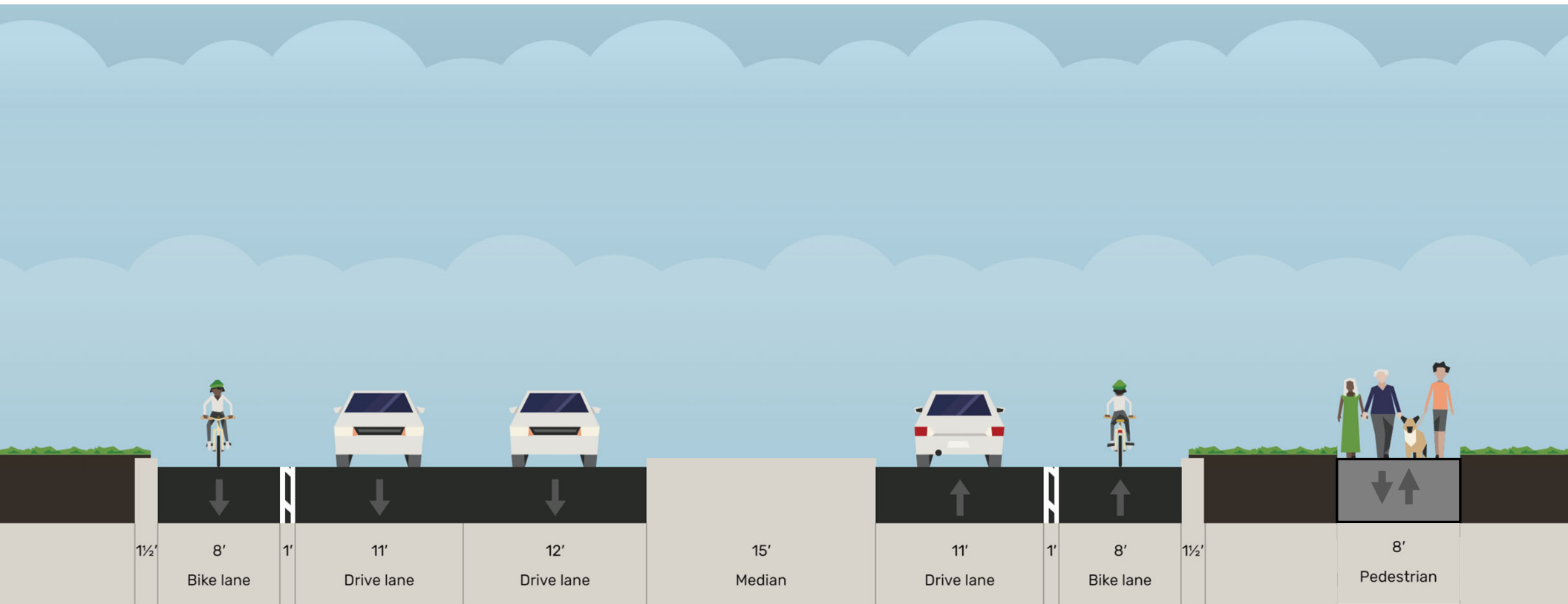
- NMDOT CN5101730
- Design Funding
 - CMAQ Federal Funds: \$213,600
 - Local Match (LGF): \$36,400
 - Total \$250,000
- Construction Funding
 - CRP Federal Funds: \$2,136,000
 - Local Match: \$364,000
 - Total \$2,500,000

- Design Complete August 2025

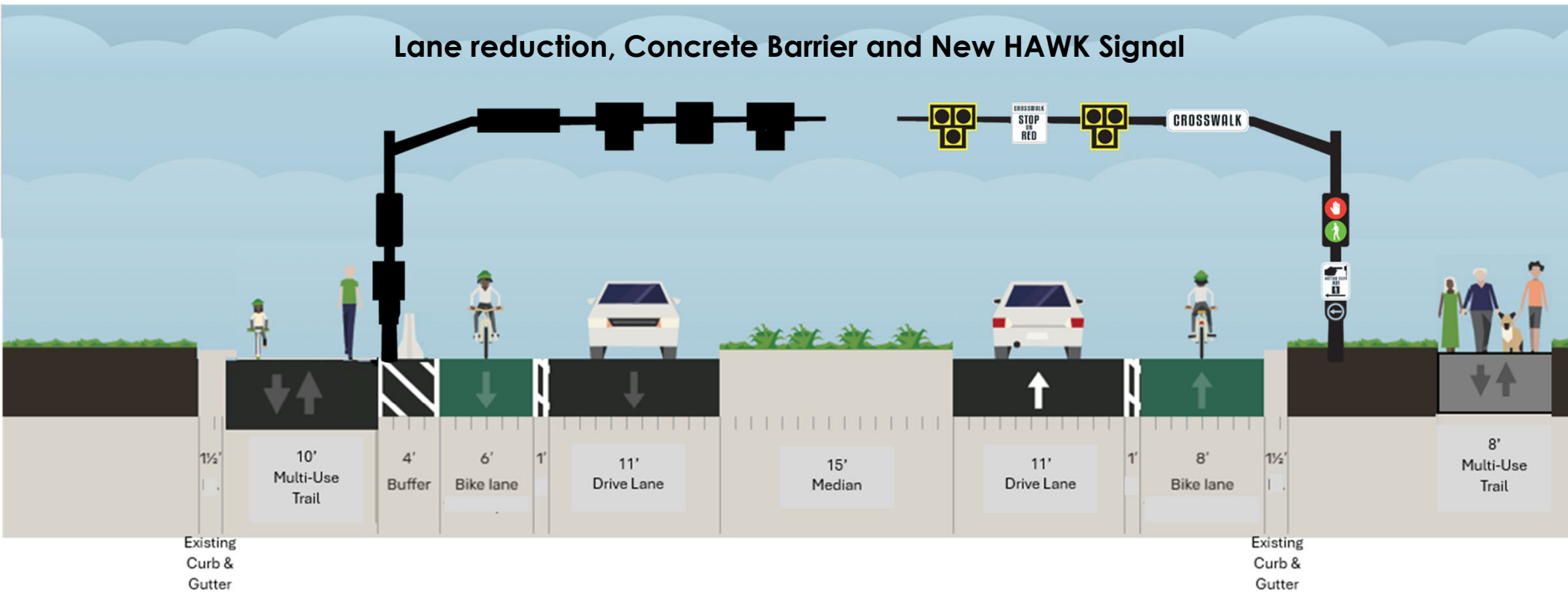

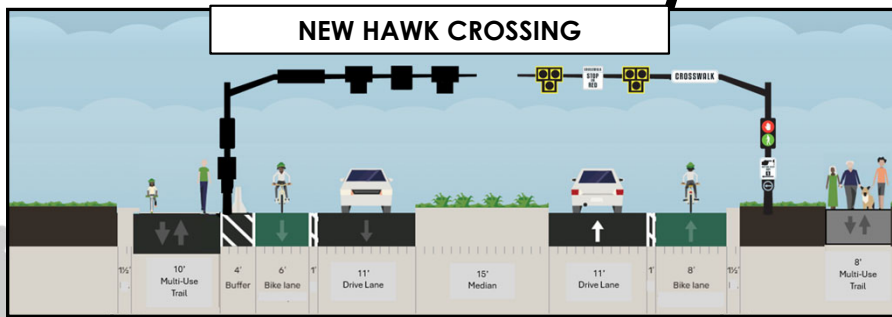
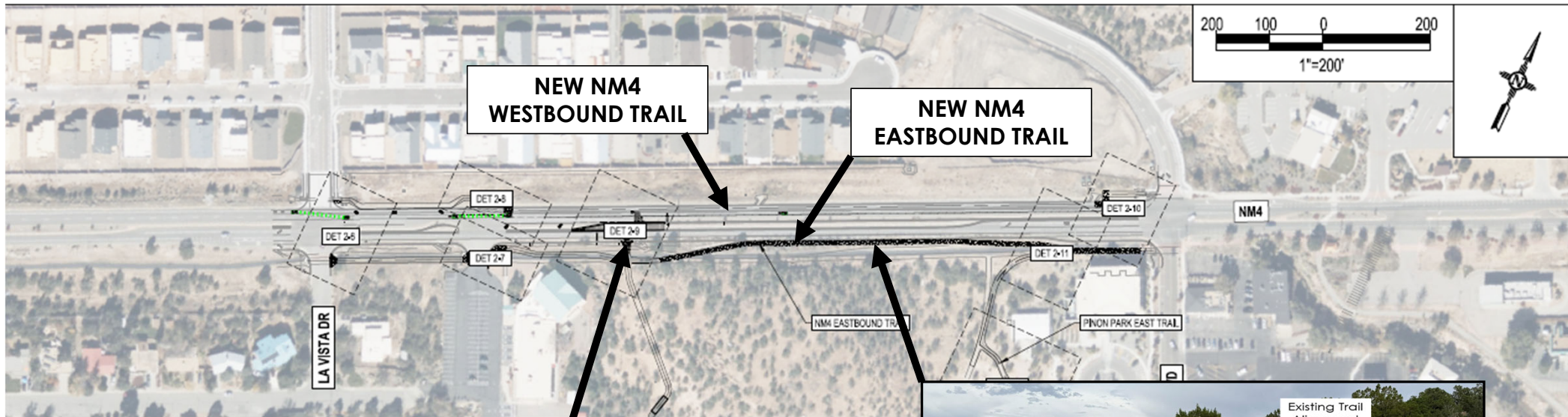
NM4 Cross Section

NM-4 ROW Plan



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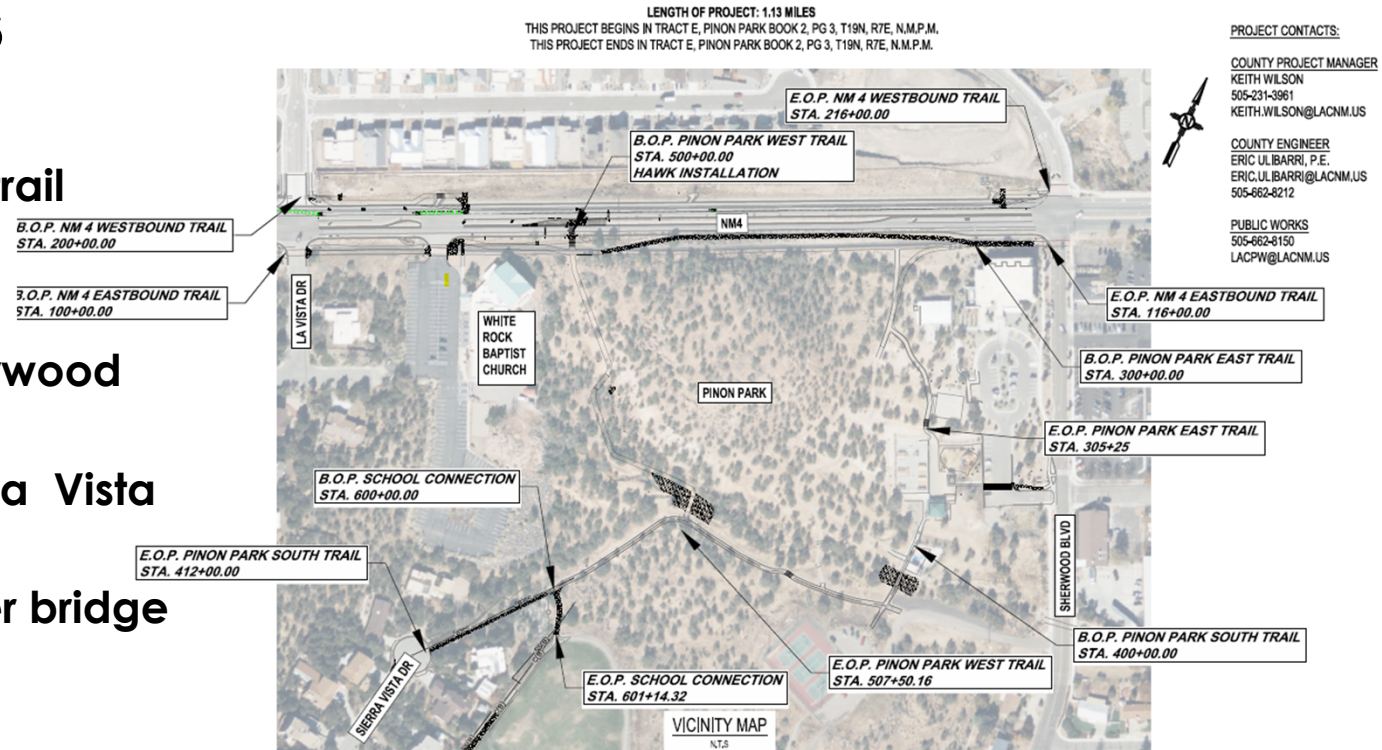
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PROJECT DETAILS

PINON PARK

- ~3000 linear feet of existing trail reconstruction
- ~750 linear feet of new trail
- Sidewalk connection to Sherwood Blvd
- Sidewalk connection to Sierra Vista Dr
- Replacing the existing timber bridge
- Drainage improvements

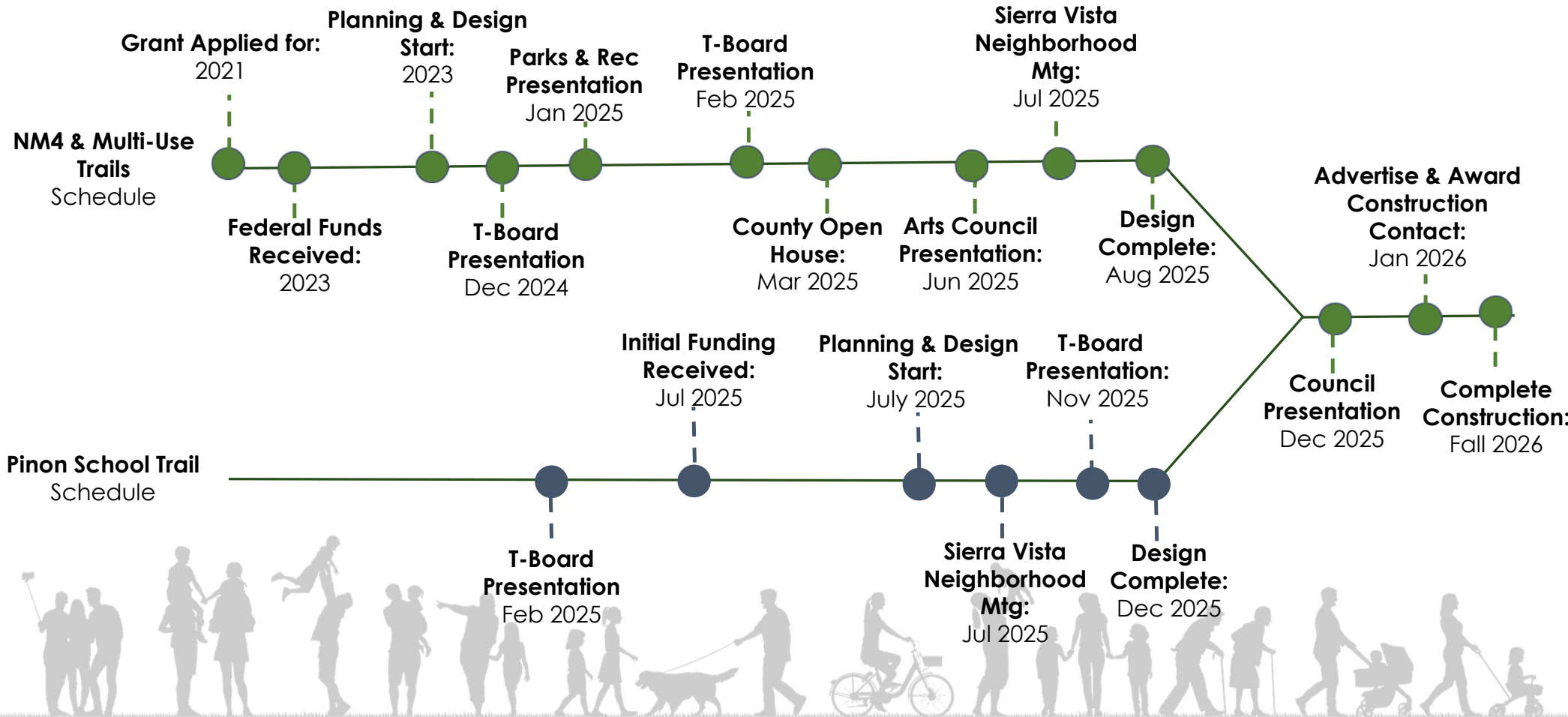
