Signed Contract Requirement for Commercial Projects

Purpose

To ensure clarity of scope, accountability, and compliance with Community Development Department requirements by requiring a signed contract between the property/business owner and the licensed contractor for all commercial projects prior to permit issuance.

Policy

1. Contract Requirement

- All commercial permit applications must include a signed contract between the property/business owner and the licensed contractor.
- The contract must contain the signatures of both the property/business owner and the licensed contractor.

2. Contractor To Be Determined (TBD)

- o If the commercial permit application lists the contractor as "To Be Determined," the permit will not be issued until:
 - a. The licensed contractor has been selected; and
 - b. A signed contract between the property/business owner and the licensed contractor has been submitted to the Community Development Department.

3. Enforcement

 Permit applications that do not meet the above requirements will be deemed incomplete and will not proceed to issuance until compliance is achieved.
