Summary of Work (Section 1.2)

The scope of work for this project involves the rehabilitation of the Bayo Non-Potable Booster Station, which serves the parks and golf course in Los Alamos during the irrigation season. Originally built in 1992, the booster station requires upgrades to ensure continued efficient operation and to meet irrigation demands, especially in pumping water up to a mesa where customers are located. These upgrades need to be completed within the irrigation downtime period, which runs from October to March.
