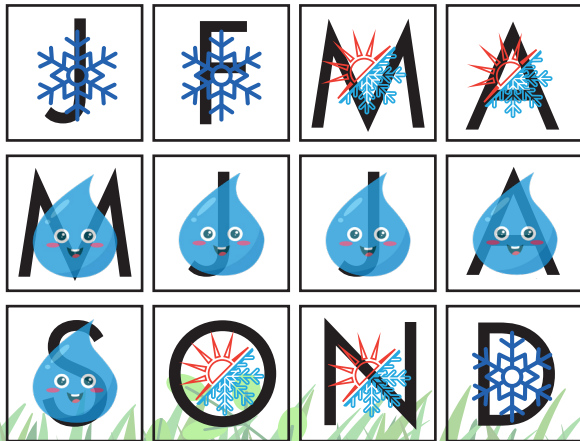
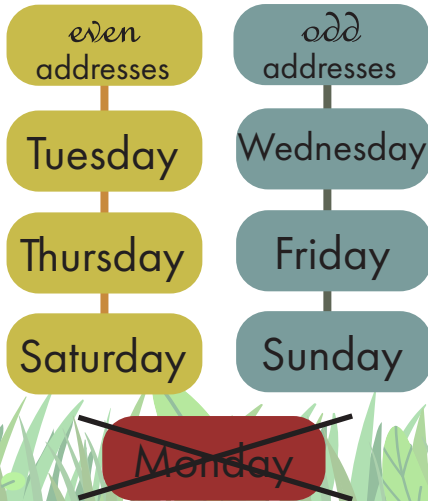


When should I water outdoors?

right month, right place, right time



DPU's Water Conservation Rule W-8 is in effect from May 1 - September 30
complete info can be found in DPU's Rules and Regulations



Water Conservation Includes

- ALL DPU customers.
- Irrigation sources delivering potable water.
- Outdoor use of water for irrigation of grass, trees, or other vegetation - including outdoor potted plants.
- Irrigation includes sprinkler systems, drip systems, and watering with a hose.

Water Conservation Excludes

- Fire Department and construction-related use.
- Irrigation sources delivering water from reuse, reclaim, gray-water, rain barrels, or private wells.
- Newly planted vegetation for a period of 1 month.
- Watering with a watering can.

How to avoid water waste

- Don't water at a rate and/or quantity to overflow landscape and cause runoff on to hard, non-landscaped surfaces.
- Maintain watering systems to only spray onto landscaped surfaces.
- Avoid washing vehicles, equipment, and hard surfaces (driveways, sidewalks, etc.) in such a manner to cause water flow onto streets.
- Always use a hose with an automatic shutoff nozzle.
- Repair leaks within 5 days of discovery.
