An Update to the Inflation Reduction Act Home Energy Efficiency Credits and Rebates

The Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) provides rebates and tax credits to eligible households for energy efficiency improvements through 2034.

TAX CREDITS: Qualifying improvements completed in 2023 may be eligible for Energy Efficient Home Improvement Credits, and certain improvements completed in 2022 may be eligible for Residential Clean Energy Credits. File Form 5695 after reading it and the instructions thoroughly!

REBATES: Rebates are not currently available for energy efficiency improvements. DPU is following updates on this program closely.

Here's what we know so far. IRA rebates will be coordinated through individual state programs. The Home Energy Rebate Program for New Mexico will be run through the Energy, Minerals, and Natural Resources Department (EMNRD). EMNRD has until Jan. 31, 2025, to apply for the funding. The Energy Conservation & Management Division is on track to submit the application well ahead of this deadline, endeavoring to expedite the program's launch and rebate distributions. So far, DPU is not aware of any guidance regarding retroactive application of rebates toward improvements completed in 2023, prior to the program's launch.


